CALLER ID ON TV FEATURE COMING FROM BRIGHT HOUSE NETWORKS

June 14, 2006 BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA— Starting this week, many Bright House Networks customers in Kern County will no longer have to reach for their phones to see who is calling them while they are watching TV. On June 8, Bright House Networks launched Caller ID on TV, a feature that displays the caller's information on a customer's television set.

“This new feature was designed to help simplify our customers lives,” said Joe Schoenstein, President of Bright House Networks Bakersfield Division. “Our roll-out of Caller ID on TV further illustrates our commitment to leverage our advanced, fiber-rich network to provide customers with value-added products and services.”

With Caller ID on TV, information including the caller's name and phone number will be displayed in the upper left-hand corner on the television screen. The new integrated feature is available to customers who have the company's Digital Phone and Digital Cable services. Customers with both of these services will automatically receive Caller ID on TV *at no additional cost* and have access to information about the last 10 incoming calls. The feature can easily be disabled and re-enabled with the remote control.

Caller ID on TV is one of several features that will appear on a new Bright House Networks on-screen navigation system called Access Menu. From the new Access Menu screen, which is accessible by pressing the yellow “A” button on our existing remote controls, customers will be able to access all the On Demand services available from Bright House Networks including Movies On Demand, Favorites On Demand, Premiums On Demand, and Bakersfield On Demand. “Access Menu offers another simple and easy way for customers to navigate through our Digital Cable offerings and access our new Caller ID on TV feature,” said Schoenstein. “This adds even more value to our digital service, and will be a very popular feature with our customers.”

Bright House Networks launched its Digital Phone service in January of 2006 and has received outstanding response and demand for the service throughout Bakersfield and Kern County. Digital Phone service allows customers to make unlimited local and long distance calls anywhere in the continental U.S. plus Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and the North Marianna Islands. *Call Waiting, Caller ID and Call Forwarding* are features currently included at no extra cost. The cost for Digital Phone is as low as \$39.95 per month.
